Data Entry: LJA Engineering completed data entry into MS4web for the construction inspections completed during the service period in compliance with TPDES General Permit No. TXR040000. Data includes photographs, field notes, and site specific information. All of this data will be utilized in the 2026 MS4 Annual Report.

Public Education Program: LJA Engineering continued the implementation of the public education program for the Jefferson County Stormwater Coalition in compliance with TPDES General Permit No. TXR040000. Public Education efforts included: Stormwater quality website updates, social media campaign, SWMP documentation updates for online posting, and open space/park reviews for appropriate pet waste signage.

Construction Site Inspections: LJA Engineering conducted construction site inspections for the City of Nederland on 8/4/2026 in compliance with TPDES General Permit No. TXR040000. A total of 11 construction inspections were conducted during the service period to identify stormwater quality violations at active construction sites.
